Introduction of DIN Pakistan

Development Institutions' Network (DIN) is a not-for-profit organization registered under society act-1860 of Pakistan. In 2016, DIN was established year 2005. DIN is working for social harmony, interfaith cohesion, and development of vulnerable segment of the society. By its nature as human-centered organization DIN is focused on socioeconomic empowerment of women, youth and children. As the existence of socio-cultural scenario on power imbalance, and discrimination at all levels for marginalized groups DIN is striving for their access to basic human rights. DIN Relief Responses

Currently, DIN is responding flood emergency response to support immediate relief affected household and communities in different villages of shikarpur district in collaboration with the different National Organization, Inter National Organization and charity organizations. Its major response areas are; food/ration, WASH, NFIs, Low-Cost House Scheme, etc.

DIN Shikarpur assessment on need basis, there after the handpumps installed the beneficiary house for providing of safe drinking water support from Muslim Charity UK . After current heavy rain flood affected community, the DIN distributed **645** ration bags to the different villages of shikarpur district with the collaboration of Muslim Charity, UK. DIN provide Two Sazgar Rickshaw to the poor and unemployed through assessment and priority basis for free of cost that they should have earn for their family members for hand to mouth with the collaboration of muslim charity, UK. DIN distributed NFIs kits to 2000 heavy rain affected families of the current heavy flood in district shikarpur with the collaboration of IOM.

DIN started construction work of low house scheme in union council Areja Taluka Khanpur, on assessment basis. Initially No: of 10 low-cost house schemes of affected people at present under progress work at the affected area with the collaboration of Muslim Charity, UK.

At present families there is much need to the heavy rain flood affected as under.

- i) **Blanket** for male, female and children wear for save from winter weather.
- ii) **Shawls** for only female to save her life in winter weather.
- iii) **Sleeping Sheets**, the affected family shall use for sleeping purpose.
- iv) **Tent** due to non-availability of rooms they live in ordinary basis in winter weather/season to save their family members.
