### Highlights

- As per UNOSAT 1.8 million people are living near stagnant water. This is down from 4.5 Million people in January
- PDMA Sind has declared an urgent need for dewatering activities in the districts of Nausharo Feroze, Khairpur, Sukkur, Jhatta, and Ghotki.
- Flood water is also stagnant in some areas of Balochistan where the risk of water borne diseases is increasing.

### Major Issue and challenges

- Some humanitarian partners have reported issues in obtaining district level NOC. Especially in KP province.
- With the expiry of EAD exemption for foreign funded projects, local NGOs are reporting delays in obtaining of EAD MOU.
