

Pakistan Floods 2022 - Situation Report#18



Highlights

- The relief activities have ended in most part of the affected areas however many families are still living in temporary shelters next to their damaged homes with limited access to food or clean drinking water.
- The flood response plan 2022 remained under funded enforcing humanitarian partners to scale down their response.
- The recovery initiatives are being carried out under the "Resilient Recovery, Rehabilitation, and Reconstruction Framework Pakistan" (4RF) developed by Ministry of Planning and special initiatives. The major component of the framework is about building




climate resilient infrastructures that will be able to withstand the future similar disasters.




Summary of Damages Floods 2022


PROVINCE WISE RELIEF




Province wise Recovery




BENEFICIARIES OF LIVELIHOOD AND CASH GRANTS

Challenges Issues- Floods 2022 response

- Collection of relief and recovery information from all stakeholders remained a challenge.
- No uniform data collection format was establish at national level which made it harder to develop a clear picture of response and recovery initiatives.
- The government has only reported the number of relief items provided while the humanitarian agencies either provided number of items or number of items or both information.
- The availability of information on relief initiatives is not easily available due to lack of central coordination mechanism.
- The government department provided inconsistent requests, numbers and assessments causing confusion among stakeholders.
